- A day in your life as a peasant farmer in ancient Egypt, based on your **notes**, the **primary source** to be found on pp. 274-5 of your textbook and other **books/internet sites**.
- A picture of a **primary source** from ancient Egypt, along with your description of the source and what it shows us about ancient Egyptian civilisation. This should include the following information, if possible:
 - **a** What does it show us about the lives of the ancient Egyptians or about their culture?
 - **b** When was it made/ written/ created/ designed/ built/made?
 - **Who** wrote/ made/ designed/ created/built it?
 - **d** What skills does it show from that period? How might these skills have affected/influenced the civilisation or helped it to develop?
 - **4 How** was it made? **From what materials**?
 - **1** What was its purpose, use or significance?
